## GRAFTED GREVILLEA INFORMATION

### General Information

#### ***Grevillea petrophiloides* “Wild Beauty”**

This plant is one of Western Australian’s most spectacular Grevilleas. It grows 1.5 m high x 1.5 m wide, with masses of red/pink bottlebrush type flowers held high above the plant on stems up to 1.5 m long. These sway in the slightest breeze and attract everyone’s attention – humans, birds, bees and butterflies. It is a very desirable and trouble-free garden plant, available in a red/pink or a creamy white form.

#### ***Grevillea flexuosa* “Zig Zag Grevillea”**

This 2 m x 2 m Western Australian plant was once thought to be extinct. It has spectacular divided foliage with showy beautiful perfumed creamy flower spikes in late winter and spring. The flowers are very well displayed and this Grevillea is appreciated both for the flowers and the very unusual foliage.

#### ***Grevillea bronwenae* “Red Ochre”**

This is another boldly different small Grevillea which grows to only 1.5 m high x 0.8 m wide. It is unusual in the profuse sprays of deep ochre-red flowers that cover the bush. It spots flowers all year but its main flowering season is winter and spring. The splash of vivid red really stands out in the winter garden. This Grevillea responds very well to tip pruning from an early age.

#### ***Grevillea dryandroides* spp *hirsuta***

*Grevillea dryandroides* is a very different looking Grevillea, with steel grey foliage held erect almost like a cycad and deep red toothbrush type flowers pushed out horizontally along the ground on long stems. It is a truly bizarre and beautiful edging or rockery plant, very tough and trouble free. It only grows to about 0.6 m high x 0.8 m wide and is a compact, neat plant that never needs pruning.

Tarrawood has a range of other grafted special Grevilleas available from time to time such as *G. thrysoides*, *G. eriobotrya* and *G. tenuiloba* etc. Please enquire to see what is available.



## Standards

Each year Tarrowood produces about 6-8 species of Grevilleas as standards. The rootstock is normally *Grevillea robusta* and the *Grevillea* species grafted on top are usually prostrate types. They are available in two heights – 1.2 m and 1.8 m. Three of our popular standards are listed below. Please enquire for current availability.

### ***Grevillea tenuiloba standards***

Spectacular tresses of rich gold flowers.

### ***Grevillea “Royal Mantle” standards***

Deep red toothbrush flowers.

### ***Grevillea nudiflora standards***

Very unusual tiny red and yellow flowers everywhere.
